Minutes of General Meeting April 27, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 9:31 a.m. by President Jeff Whetzel. The board members then introduced themselves: 1st Vice President—Jim Hurst; 2nd Vice President/Rally Master—Dave Riker; Secretary—Eunice Johnson; Treasurer—Robyn Moore. Jeff then recognized and thanked George and Glenda Pirie for their work on the newsletter.

Committee Reports:

Jim Hurst reported that upcoming rallies are posted on the website. The 2009 rally sites are as follows: February—Fidalgo Bay; March—Glen Ayre; April 30 (Homecoming)—Lacey; June—Stars and Stripes in Ephrata; August—Swiss Park at Bonney Lake; September—Hartstene Island; October—Lacey. A suggestion was made to try to coordinate dates with the Olympic Snowbirds to avoid schedule conflicts.

Dave Riker reported that wagon masters are in place for rallies through August of 2009.

The secretary reported that the minutes of the previous meeting were available on the website. Dave Osborn moved that those minutes be approved as they appear on the web. The motion was seconded and approved.

Robyn Moore gave the treasurer's report. He had no exact figures but reported that the club ended last year on the plus side with about \$18,000 in the treasury. Dues will now need to be collected by December 10 as we need to report our membership to FMCA by the end of the year.

National Director's report: Jerry Lehenbauer said that all planning and all details for the NW regional rally in Albany in June is available on the website www.fmcanw.org. Members may call AON Insurance to request a quote and by doing so, AON will pay \$10 toward member dues.

Glenda Pirie reported that shirt sales were going well, with 27 additional orders over the weekend. Shirt price is now \$23. If someone would like to order a shirt, call or email Glenda.

George Pirie reminded people to submit articles and information for the newsletter.

Webmaster Jim Hurst has added a Hot Topics section to the site. He will add meeting minutes and mini rally information.

There will be a mini rally beginning today at Lake Chelan. There is also a mini rally after the Twisp rally in June. It will be led by Tom and Jay Baxter and is to wine country near Prosser. There are 3 places left. There will also be a mini rally over New Years to Glen Ayre on

Hood Canal being organized by Ralph and Coleen Schmitt. It will have to be limited to about 20 coaches due to size of the club house.

A question was asked about the GARV trailer. It is presently stored at the Marshes and is being used for storage of GARV supplies. No decision has been made on selling it.

There being no further business, Dave Osborn moved the meeting be adjourned. It was seconded and passed by voice vote. The meeting was adjourned at 9:57 a.m.
